Riders must be a minimum of Grade F Showjumping. A gear check will take place before the lesson. Riders will be grouped according to their grade and/or riding ability where possible.

Groups will be made up of a maximum of 6 riders. Each session is 1.5 hrs. There is a limit on the number of riders and those riders that attend both days will be given priority.
