#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgment that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- 2. Before riding, all competitors in the Open Sections must sign a Day Attendance and Biosecurity Form at the office and pay a fee of \$10.00. However, PCAV members who present a current membership card are exempt from the fee.
- 3. All pony club riders must present their cards for inspection and complete the biosecurity information at the secretary's office before riding.
- 4. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate (less \$10 administration fee).
- 5. Entries will be accepted in the order that they are received and numbers in each section will be restricted. The Committee reserves the right to close entries to any grade or section prior to the closing date upon receipt of allotted number of entries in a section or grade being reached.
- 6. PCAV members may ride in either Pony Club or Open Section or both as per PCAV Handbook of By-Laws
- 7. Competitors may ride more than one horse competitively, subject to ballot of entries. Preferences will be based on entry order.
- 8. All riders must wear complying helmets as per PCAV gear rules. Spot checks may occur.
- Medical Armbands must be worn by ALL COMPETITORS.
- 10. Full Pony Club uniform to be worm. Open riders may wear HRCAV uniform, Pony Club uniform, neat polo/rugby style top or jackets and pale coloured Jodhpurs or moleskins.
- 11. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws
- 12. Dogs and alcohol are prohibited without exception.
- 13. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- 14. Competitor numbers will be allocated by the organising committee. Bridle or saddlecloth numbers must be provided by competitors.
- 15. Gear check is required for all riders prior to each dressage test or before Showjumping. Competitors must present to Gear Check 20 prior to allocated time of each test. Competitors not complying will be eliminated. PCAV gear rules apply.
- 16. This event will comply with the PCAV EI and Biosecurity Guidelines which are current at the time of the event.
- 17. Neither the organising committee of this competition, Seymour Pony Club Inc. nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness of horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- 18. Lunging is permitted in the confined designated "lunging only" area this area is the round yard. Ancillary lunging equipment such as pessoa, chambon and side reins are not permitted. Only the competitor may lunge his horse or pony. Competitors not complying will be eliminated.
- 19. All classes are subject to sufficient entries being received.
- 20. The committee of the Seymour Pony Club Inc. reserves the right to cancel any class or event, alter the advertised times, divide any class and refuse entry to any competitor or person with or without stating the reason.
- 21. Dressage tests in all open sections may be called.
- 22. Dressage jackpot scoring. Points will be allocated as per the following for each test. 1st place 5 points, 2nd place 3 points, 3rd place 2 points, 4th place 1 point. Highest aggregate of the two tests is the winner. In the case of a draw, The 2013 PCAV Handbook of By-laws separating equality of scores will be used.
