*Clinic will include: 1 x 45 min Dressage Lesson, 1 x 45 min SJ Lesson, 1 x 1 Hour XC Lesson each day.*

**Numbers will be limited, entries will be on a First in, first paid basis.**

This clinic is aimed at Riders competing at Grade 4 or 5 as well as Ungraded Riders.

**This clinic is only open to Pony Club Riders.**

Groups will be done according to Horse Trials Grading where possible. Riders can ride on one or both days.

Dress Code: Approved helmets and boots (No singlet tops).

### **BYO LUNCH & DRINKS**

Cost of clinic is \$80 per day for MPC members, \$90 per day for Non MPC members.

Camping and Yards available: \$10 per yard and \$10 camping fee per family.

Entries close 24<sup>th</sup> December or earlier, if full.

### **Rules and Conditions of Entry:**

Medical Armbands must be worn by all riders for all lessons. Gear check is required for each lesson, Riders cards need to be checked before riding. PCAV Horse Abuse Rules apply. If bringing own yards, they must conform to PCAV requirements. No use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains. Electric tape may be used as a top line or stand off to a steel or solid yard but not as a stand alone. No Lunging. More than one mount may be ridden subject of PCAV Handbook of Bylaws multiple horses rules. Neither the organisers of this clinic nor the instructors nor PCAV nr the landowners accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, and spectators or any other persons or property. The Organisers of the clinic reserve the right to cancel any class, alter or refuse any entry with or without stating a reason. Refund of monies paid (minus admin fee of 10%) will occur only on presentation of Medical or Veterinary Certificate before closing date. The clinic will run under PCAV rules and entering this clinic constitutes acceptance of these rules. Every child must have a parent or guardian present whilst riding. PCAV alcohol, smoke free and sun smart policies apply. Organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone due to extreme weather policy. If bringing own yards, they must conform to PCAV requirements: No use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains. Electric tape may be used as a top line or stand off to a steel or solid yard but not as stand alone. NO STALLIONS, COLTS or RIGS.
