Conditions of Entry

(In accordance with new PCV rules effective January 2018)

- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement and acceptance of PCV rules.
- Cross Country course will be closed from **Midnight 31 March 2018**. Any riders found on the course during the 2 weeks leading up to the competition may be eliminated.
- The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. To be produced within 7 days. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- **ATTENDANCE CARDS:** Pony Club cards are to be produced when collecting back numbers. Cards can be collected when back numbers are returned to the Card Secretary.
- Medical armbands must be worn and displayed on the upper arm for all three phases.
- Gear check at least 20 mins before riding each phase of the Competition is required for all riders
- XC jump Judges: each club **MUST** provide one cross country judge for the first rider and then one every 3 riders or part thereof entered.
- Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws (35).
- PCV code of conduct applies any conduct unbecoming of a competitor, including bad language, is a reportable incident and may lead to disqualification.
- PCV Alcohol policy applies as per Handbook of By-Laws (26).
- Correct 'standard's helmet must be worn as specified in the PCV Gear Rules. Spot checks will occur and an incorrect helmet will mean elimination.

- Bridle and saddlecloth numbers may be used for the Dressage and Showjumping phases.
- Back numbers will be supplied to all riders in pony club classes. **Open riders must provide their own number holders**, printed numbers will be supplied.
- Open Riders to wear beige or white jodhpurs with jackets or club colours.
- Pony Club riders must wear approved registered pony club uniform, approved helmet, Jodhpurs/breeches of banana, cream, fawn, white or beige colour, boots and a sleeved garment.
- Hair must be tied up for XC so back numbers can be seen by the XC fence judges.
- Lunging is not permitted at this competition.
- Horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- Any rider under eight years of age may not compete.
- Competitors may enter more than one horse subject to the ballot of entries and conditions of PCV Handbook of By-Laws multiple horse rules. Please indicate your preference on the entry form.
- **Open Riders:**
 - a. Must complete the Public Liability Declaration Form;
 - b. Pay \$10 day attendance fee **per day for the duration of the event** unless you are a financial member of PCV, EA, HRCVA, an Inter State Pony Club, AHSA, AERA or can provide proof that you are covered by a Public Liability Insurance Policy of at least \$10,000,000. **Participants must provide proof of current membership or insurance cover to the Card Secretary or pay the fee;**
 - c. # Riders without proof of adequate insurance cover pay \$10 for Liability Only Cover for the duration of the event and must complete the Participant Waiver;
 - d. PCV club member cards must be inspected at the Secretary's office. **PCV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCV rules may be left uninsured.**
- Camping will be available in designated areas at \$10.00 per night/per vehicle and must be paid with entry form. Yards are limited, at \$10.00 and must be booked and paid for with entry.
- **Those camping will be given 1st preference for yards.**
- Portable yards, should be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains, is not permitted. Electric tape can be used as a top line "standoff" on a steel or solid yard, but not as a standalone yard.
- **Strictly no Dogs allowed at this event**, elimination will occur if not adhered to.

Saturday Night Dinner & Auction

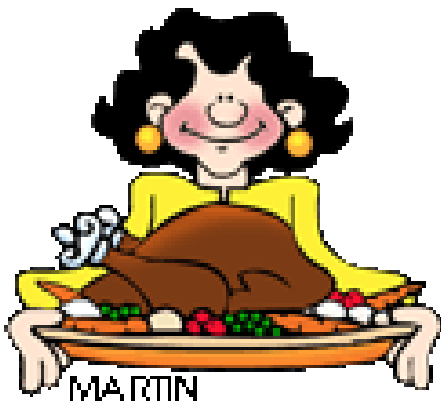
This year we are having a dinner on the Sat night with an Auction, so come enjoy a lovely meal, good company and enjoy the fun and have a bid or two in our auction.
