CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. ENTRY FEE is \$25 per Pony Club block entry, \$40 per Open block entry (includes \$10 day membership)
2. Before riding all OPEN riders must complete a day attendance form. If a current Pony Club card is presented, entry is only \$30.
3. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretaries office before riding
4. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An administration fee of \$10 will be deducted
5. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules
6. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times, refuse any entry with or without stating the reason
7. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
8. OPEN riders to wear hunting attire or HRCav uniform.
9. Gear check: All riders require gear check before riding.
10. Armbands are required to be worn by all competitors (including non-pony club).
11. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
12. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
13. No stallions, colts or rigs, horses must be at least 4yrs old.
14. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCAV 'Multiple Horse' Rules
15. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
16. Lungeing is only permitted in the confined, designated area.
17. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

Mansfield's PERFECT MATCH rules:

A jumping event for E and F Graders to replace the old Rescue Relay.

How well can you match your partner's time taken around the SJ course?

The pair of riders that has times around the course that are the CLOSEST to each other will WIN.

It doesn't matter if you are fast or slow, as long as you both ride to nearly the same time (as close as possible).

Your score will be the DIFFERENCE between your two times;

For Example:- Rider A takes 72 seconds; Rider B takes 67 seconds; Score $72 - 65 = 5$ seconds.

The closer the times are, the lower the score is, and the better the result ! (with the lowest penalties).

Knockdowns and refusals are given penalties as for normal events, but you can't be eliminated by refusals.

If you have 2 refusals for the same jump, you may move on to the next jump. Missing a jump incurs 8 seconds time penalty – added to the time difference.

If the first rider in the pair is eliminated by falling off, the second rider may withdraw before starting and pair with an unattached partner.

Riders can be from **different** clubs but must be graded in the same grade.
