All riders riding in Open sections must complete attached Liability Declaration form and if not member of EA, HRC AV, Interstate PC, AERA, Arabian Horse Society or PCAV must pay \$10 day membership, in addition to entry fee. Please bring relevant paperwork and proof of membership and present this prior to riding on the day. The \$10 fee if applicable is not part of the entry fee and must be paid on the day.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Pony club riders \$35, open riders \$40 (includes \$5 facility fee). Limited yards and camping are available.

1. PCV club member cards must be presented to the secretary's office for inspection.
2. Show Jumping Numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors must supply their own Numbers.
3. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.
4. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that the current PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
5. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
6. Equality of scores will be separated as per Handbook of Bylaws - showjumping bylaw 38.3.a – Championship scoring to be used
7. Lungeing is not permitted. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.
8. All riders must wear complying helmets. Helmets must comply with PCV standards Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
9. All pony club members must wear uniform. All non-pony club riders must wear cream/fawn jodhpurs, fawn moleskins, white shirt, tie and coat or HRC AV uniform.
10. Gear check is required by all riders prior to competition.
11. Medical Armbands MUST be worn by ALL competitors.
12. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
13. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
14. No stallions, colts or rigs, horses must be at least 4yrs old.
15. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
16. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
17. Competitors may ride more than one horse subject to PCV rules
18. Condition of Entry includes agreeing to Horse Veterinary Authority and Medical Response Authority found at following link

19. Stabling and yards should be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains is not permitted at Pony Club events. Electric tape can be used as a top line or 'standoff' on a steel or solid yard, but not as a stand alone yard.
