There will be no refunds on unused tickets. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason. All riders must wear complying helmets as specified in PCV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.

Gear check is compulsory for all pony club and open competitions (except open show rings). Medical Armbands must be worn by all competitors applies to pony club and all open sections.

Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws. Dogs are prohibited without exception. No stallions, colts or rigs. PCV Alcohol Policy applies. Lunging is not permitted at this competition. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property. PCV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCV Rules may be left uninsured.
