Your choice of up to 4 of any of the following:

1 x hour Dressage Lesson, 1 x hour Showjumping Lesson and/or 1.5 Hour XC Lesson

Groups will be a maximum of 3 riders for SJ and Dressage and 6 for XC

Numbers will be limited, entries will be on a First in, first paid basis.

This clinic is aimed at Riders competing at confident Grade 4 and above – you will need to produce your cards for proof of grading. Groups will be allocated according to Horse Trials Grading where possible. Riders can choose which lessons they attend and will be charged accordingly.

Dress Code: Approved helmets and boots (No singlet tops) Back protectors must be worn for XC. Armbands are optional but highly recommended.

BYO LUNCH & DRINKS

Cost is \$75 for 1 x lesson, \$140 for 2 x lessons, \$200 for 3 x lessons and \$240 for 4 x lessons. (Priority will be given to those riders who book 4 x lessons) you can choose which lessons you would like on your entry form to a maximum of 4 x lessons per horse over the weekend. (2 x lessons per day, per horse). Open Riders must sign Day Attendance Form and provide proof of insurance or pay \$15 Day Attendance Fee.

Camping & Yards available (weekend rate): \$20 per outside yard, \$30 u/cover yard & \$15 camping fee per family.

Rules and Conditions of Entry:

Gear check is required for each lesson, Riders cards need to be checked before riding. PCV Horse Abuse Rules apply. If bringing own yards, they must conform to PCV requirements. No use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains. Electric tape may be used as a top line or stand off to a steel or solid yard but not as a stand alone. No Lunging. More than one mount may be ridden subject of PCV Handbook of Bylaws multiple horses rules. Neither the organisers of this clinic nor the instructors nor PCV nor the landowners accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, and spectators or any other persons or property. The Organisers of the clinic reserve the right to cancel any class, alter or refuse any entry with or without stating a reason. Refund of monies paid (minus admin fee of 10%) will occur only on presentation of Medical or Veterinary Certificate before closing date. The clinic will run under PCV rules and entering this clinic constitutes acceptance of these rules. Every child must have a parent or guardian present whilst riding. PCV alcohol, smoke free and sun smart policies apply. Organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone due to extreme weather policy. NO STALLIONS, COLTS or RIGS. Current State COVID restriction will be provided with the draw.
