### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

*ENTERING* this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV Rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

*ELIGIBILITY*: PCAV Club Member Cards are required at Zone Events and will be inspected thoroughly to ensure eligibility is in accordance with the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws (Feb 2013) *Club officials please check eligibility of each rider*.

**MULTIPLE HORSES:** More than one horse can be ridden subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-Laws multiple horse rules.

**STATEMENT OF RIGHTS:** The organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times and refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

**REFUND POLICY:** No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate, however, administration and/ or facility fees will be deducted.

*MEDICAL ARMBANDS*: ALL competitors must wear armbands. Armbands may be inspected randomly at gear check to ensure competitors name and emergency contacts are correct.

HELMETS: Correct 'standards" numbered helmets must be worn as specified I PCAV Gear Rules. Spot check will occur. Complying Helmets AS/NZS3838, - EN 1384, - ASTMF1163, - PAS015.

*GEAR CHECK*: Gear check is required before the commencement of the competition. Gear Rules for Gymkhana and Showing will be enforced.

**QUERIES, PROTESTS & HORSE ABUSE RULES** as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.

### DOG POLICY: STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED

HORSES must be at least four years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.

LUNGEING No Lunging permitted on the ground as there is no secure lunging area.
